Since 2013, SwissLimbs, trained more than 250 orthopedic technicians, performed over 40 training missions, has donated more than 2,500 prosthetic limbs, created 7 orthopedic clinics in Africa, built a rehabilitation center in a refugees settlement in Uganda and built a rehabilitation hospital in Tanzania.

Creation and rehabilitation of ortho-prosthetic workshops,

• Specialized training for technicians on site: SwissLimbs has a pool of specialized trainers

at home and abroad, who teach orthopedic professionals in the most innovative low-cost orthoprosthetic technologies.
